

FY2011 COC COMPETITION UPDATE

TECHNICAL CORRECTION FOR FY2011 COC NOFA

The attached Technical Correction Notice corrects language in Section III.C. Renewal Eligibility on page 23 of the FY 2011 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Programs NOFA published on August 30, 2011. The only change is in the third sentence of the first paragraph. The change **does not** affect the rating or ranking of applications, substantively change the NOFA, nor does it change the submission deadline. No action is required by CoCs or project applicants. The Technical Correction Notice will also be available on HUD's [Homelessness Resource Exchange](#) (HRE) and [HUD's website](#).

The correct language for Section III. C. Renewal eligibility reads:

- C. Renewal eligibility:** To be eligible to submit an application (Exhibit 2) for renewal funding for SHP and S+C projects, the project applicant must have an existing grant agreement with HUD and must be approved by the CoC to be included with the consolidated application. The only exception to the existing grant agreement requirement is for the 1-year new projects awarded under the FY2010 Homeless Assistance Programs competition. HUD will not select renewal projects for an award unless their grant agreement has been signed by both HUD and the recipient; the project is operating; and the project meets one of the following additional eligibility requirements:

This correction does **NOT** impact the submission deadline, funding criteria, and other requirements for the FY2011 CoC NOFA. The deadline for application submission remains **October 28, 2011** at 7:59:59 p.m. Eastern Time.

e-snaps OUTAGE
