

HUD HDX CORRECTED ANNOUNCEMENT & 2010 COC REGISTRATION NOTICE WEBCAST UPDATE

HUD HDX – REVISED TRAINING SCHEDULE BELOW

Data collected for the 2010 Housing Inventory and Point-in-Time Counts will not be submitted with the 2010 Continuum of Care application on *e-snaps*. Instead, data for these two counts will be entered directly into a new HUD Homelessness Data Exchange (HDX) web site. The system will be available for data entry beginning on May 1, 2010. CoCs will be able to enter 2010 Housing Inventory and Point-in-Time counts into the HDX from May 1 through May 31, 2010.

CONTINUUM OF CARE REGISTRATION PROCESS

The primary contact within each Continuum of Care (CoC) will have the responsibility of registering and assigning read, write, and submit authority to persons within their community who will be responsible for entering and submitting data for the Housing Inventory Count (HIC) and the Homeless Point-in-Time Count (PIT).

The following steps will need to be taken in order to access the HDX:

Create User Accounts at HMIS.INFO: All users who need view, edit, or submit authority for the HDX must first establish a user account at HMIS.info. To establish an HMIS.info account, users should click the following link:

Registering Users for HDX: To register additional users to HDX, the COC primary contact enter must enter each user's First Name, Last Name, and email address.. NOTE: If the CoC primary contact adds a user that has not yet registered with HMIS.info, an alert will appear informing the primary contact that the person has not registered with HMIS.info.

Register and Attend HDX Training (corrected schedule): All CoC primary contacts and the individuals who will be assigned to enter data should plan on attending one of the five scheduled webinar trainings. These sessions will review how to assign data submission privileges and how to enter data into the site. All times are Eastern Daylight Time (EDT).
