In its effort to implement the [National HIV/AIDS Strategy](#), HUD seeks ideas and input on how to revise the current formula for allocating HOPWA funds in order to effectively distribute funding to serve existing needs.

HUD will host a webinar on **March 28, 2011, at 2:00 pm EST**. Registration information is below.

This webinar, along with the open comment section at the [HUD Ideas in Action](#) website, are part of HUD's effort to seek input from stakeholders in order to hear the best ideas for strengthening the HOPWA program. HUD asks interested parties to consider the following questions:

☐ Besides the number of people living with HIV/AIDS, what other factors should HUD consider in a revision to the HOPWA funding formula?

☐ The current HOPWA formula distributes 25% of funding as a "bonus" to those areas challenged with above-average AIDS incidence. Should HUD continue to use a high-incidence factor in its funding formula?

☐ Aside from using a high-incidence "bonus" factor, how can HUD target HOPWA resources to areas of greatest need and most concentrated disadvantage?

☐ Is there a greater role for State agencies, Public Housing Authorities, homeless assistance projects, or other agencies to administer HOPWA grants?
