

New HPRP Resources and Quarterly Reporting Reminders

New HRE Resources:

- There are new resources posted on the HRE website:
 - HPRP Reporting Deadlines – A cumulative cheat sheet for all HPRP reporting deadlines including preliminary deadlines, extensions, and final due dates for both FederalReporting.gov and e-snaps QPRs and APRs is now available at: http://www.hudhre.info/documents/HPRP_ReportingDeadlines.pdf
 - Updated Status Reports on HPRP Spending – *Grantees are required to expend 60% of their award funds within two years of the date that HUD signed the grant agreement.* These reports contain listings of all HPRP grantees, their current expenditure rates as measured by draw-downs of funds from IDIS, and projections as to whether each grantee will meet the requirement. There are 3 PDF documents containing updated data as of 3/28/11, sorted in 3 different ways:
 - By the projected gap in meeting the 2 year 60% requirement
 - By the percentage of funds drawn down from IDIS
 - By percent of funds drawn within the grantee state

Reporting is Now Open!

- The next HPRP quarterly reporting period begins today, Friday, April 1st. FederalReporting.gov and e-snaps are both open for quarterly reporting on the grant period from January 1, 2011 – March 31, 2011.
- The statutory deadline for submitting both reports is April 10th, 1011. Note that both FederalReporting.gov and e-snaps will remain open for reporting until April 14th at midnight ET, and reports will not be flagged as late.

- If you have a question about an error message in e-snaps, please attach a screen shot of the error message to the question submitted on the Help Desk. HUD cannot answer questions about specific reporting errors without looking at the error and the data itself, so it is important grantees include a screen shot of the error.
