### HUD's Year 1 HPRP APR: Lessons Learned and Next Steps

In January 2011, HPRP grantees submitted to HUD their Year 1 HPRP APRs. On **Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 am (EDT)** and again on **Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 pm (EDT)**, HUD will host a webinar reviewing "lessons learned" from this process, to inform grantees' submissions of the HPRP APR in Years 2 and 3. Topics will include:

- common errors on APR questions,
- common issues with HMIS affecting APR data,
- suggestions for reducing errors and improving the quality of the data submitted to HUD,
- a review of some of the commonly misunderstood reporting concepts, and
- some national outcomes from the first year of HPRP.

**Audience:** HPRP grantee staff responsible for APR submission; HPRP subgrantee staff who enter data in HMIS and/or are responsible for submitting data to the HPRP grantee; other key reporting staff and stakeholders, including HMIS vendors, HMIS System Administrators, etc.
