**Using IDIS Online for the Emergency Solutions Grants Program**

This webinar will provide an introduction on the use of IDIS Online for the Emergency Solutions Grants Program. This introduction will detail:

- Proper ESG project and activity setup protocols that differ significantly from the Emergency Shelter Grants program procedures.
- Activity funding procedures that require recipients to select the specific subrecipient organizations that receive funding for related activities.
- ESG drawdown procedures that require subrecipient organization designation during the drawdown process.

This webinar will also detail the specific IDIS instructions for 2011 that arose because there are two allocations of ESG (known as the first and second allocations). These conditions will only arise in 2011 and should be carefully followed as recipients complete the setup of their second allocation of ESG funds in IDIS.

**Determining Homeless and At-Risk Status, Income and Disability**

**December 13, 2011**

**3:30 – 4:30 PM ET**

This webinar will provide a comprehensive introduction to HUD's Homeless Definition Final Rule and the new at-risk of homelessness definition included in the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program Final Rule. These definitions must be adhered to when screening potential participants for ESG assistance, as well as assistance provided by HUD Supportive Housing Program (SHP) and Shelter Plus Care (SPC) program recipients with new or renewal projects starting on or after 1/1/2012.

The webinar will review how to determine housing status (homeless, at-risk of homelessness), income and disability, as well as a general review of related record-keeping requirements and documentation standards. This webinar will NOT cover details specific to potential participant eligibility under each ESG component or to SHP or the SPC program, nor the specific documentation requirements related to each housing status and income type. More detailed training on documentation requirements will be covered during a later webinar.
